All has been quiet in the Stronghold since our preparations to attend the Camps of War in our Barony of Ruantallan. The mundane world has required too much attention from too many of us, and our projects within our Dream have felt the lack of time to call our own. However, with the completion of the faux stained glass window for the Big Red Barn project (requiring it only to be tacked to a light frame and set in place), that project is about finished. Therefore, I shall email some pictures to the moas@eastkingdom.org address, as I cannot see any way to send them via this form. I shall include pictures of the barn, and also the kingdom and baronial populace banners we made for the group, to add some colour to our local events. The Tir Mara banner is still to be completed. Ends up that one can make dollar store acrylic craft paints into waterproof (and allegedly washable!) fabric paints by mixing in some stuff called Fabric Medium, which happily is also available at the dollar store (the brand is DecoArt). I've mentioned the banners in previous reports, but in order to make them, the fabric was trimmed to the correct size and hemmed, with a channel sewn along the top, and the design was printed out from the

computer, full-sized, and taped together. The pattern, and the thin cloth of the banner, were held to an appropriately-sized square of thin plywood with clamps, and the outline, visible through the cloth, was traced in black paint onto the banner. Once the outline was complete, it was coloured in. Ribbon ties were later added to the ends of the sleeve to allow it to be hung from poles larger than the sleeve permitted, or to be tied from, say, a tent frame. Worked very nicely!
